

Board Meeting Minutes September 20, 2012

The Charlevoix County Department of Human Services Board held its regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday, September 20, 2012, at Grandvue Medical Care Facility in East Jordan. Mr. B. Olstrom presented Mr. Bloom with a plaque and expressed appreciation from the DHS Board for Mr. Bloom's years of dedicated service.

Mr. B. Olstrom moved to approve the agenda with the addition of 1) a motion for approval of a capital expenditure in excess of budgeted amount for computer network switches, 2) a closed session to discuss collective bargaining, and 3) a motion to approve the write off of bad debt; second by Mr. Pawlus.

Mrs. Timmer showed the Board the award the facility received from My InnerView for superior commitment to customer satisfaction. The Board also reviewed the first sample menu that will be in use when restaurant style dining is fully implemented.
