WE BELIEVE IN PERSON CENTERED CARE

Simply defined, person centered care is a dignified approach to living and caring for elders to create long term care communities where elders choose to live their lives with staff members who enjoy assisting them. Person centered care allows our residents to maintain control over the decisions that affect each area of their lives. We work in collaboration with our residents to fill in the gaps of their abilities instead of simply doing tasks for them.

- In 2010, Grandvue achieved a 98% satisfaction rating in our annual Resident and Family Satisfaction Survey
- Grandvue exceeded budgeted census figures, achieving 98.49% census for the year
- Grandvue maintained a 5-Star Excellence Rating as determined by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services
- Grandvue was listed as one of the best nursing homes in the nation by <u>US News and World Report</u>

Continuing staff education and advancement from within are important components in our dedication to excellence. - Facility turnover has steadily decreased from 30% in 2007 to 17.7% in 2010







TOTAL DAYS OF SKILLED CARE PROVIDED

In 2010 Grandvue's occupancy rate averaged 98.4%, and the facility provided the equivalent of 40,674 days of skilled care for our residents. Grandvue provided 24-hour care including meals, activities, therapies, laundry service, utilities and home maintenance for about \$13.29 per resident hour.

OPPORTUNITIES TO HELP US CARE

Our Grandvue family benefits from the time, talents and financial gifts donated by members of the community:

Volunteers enhance the lives of our residents by helping facilitate weekly outings, bingo games, and other group activities and events. They also assist with nail care, letter writing and other individualized activities.
